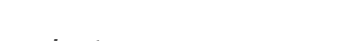

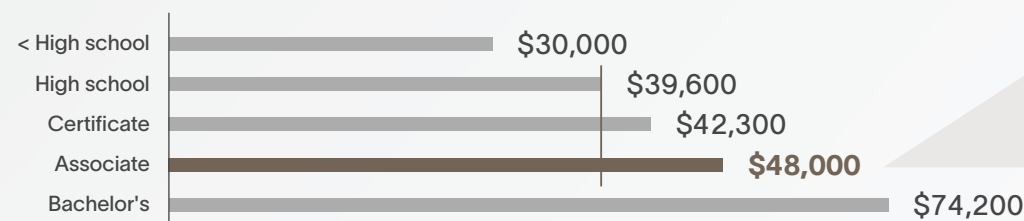

Average earnings by education level at career midpoint



The average associate degree graduate from CCIL will see an increase in earnings of **\$8,400** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in Illinois.

For every \$1...



Students gain **\$4.30** in lifetime earnings



Taxpayers gain **\$1.30** in added tax revenue and public sector savings



Society gains **\$6.70** in added income and social savings
